Looking back over the time between when Crossroads Pregnancy Center first began to where it is now, I am amazed.

On March 19, 1985, the first office of Crossroads opened in Lewistown. Staffed by all volunteers, this ministry hit the ground running. We offered self-administered pregnancy tests with options counseling and post-abortion services. That year there were 105 visits with clients.

I've been a part of this journey with Crossroads since October of 2002 and the time has passed by so quickly. It is such a joy to see a new mother, who first came to us seeking an abortion, look into the eyes of her precious newborn baby with such love and peace. It is a great honor and privilege to watch a client go from lost to found through the course of their time with us as we share the love, hope, and truth that Jesus brings. I have been a witness to the fruits of what began as a thought after a Bible study one night in 1983 to the wonderful, far-reaching ministry it is today. Our four locations now serve three counties of central Pennsylvania. In 2019, there were 1,689 visits with clients.

With all the initiatives we have at present, which you can see listed in this report, we are reaching out to a world that needs help, hope, and healing now more than ever. We have the opportunity to be the hands and feet of Jesus in practical ways to people, some of whom may never step inside the doors of a church. God is doing a great work at Crossroads through our staff, volunteers, and friends of the ministry—all made possible because of your financial support. All of the donations we receive are handled with great care and integrity. I want to personally thank each of you who has partnered with us to make this life-saving ministry possible.

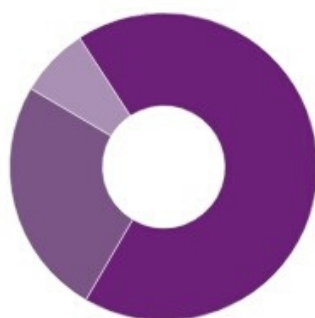

SERVICES

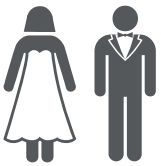
Since Crossroads inception, we have added many client initiatives like those you see listed here:

- Referrals to other community agencies and organizations



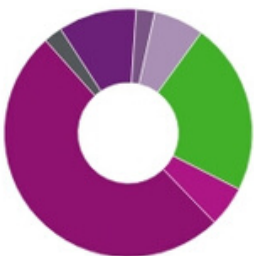
TIME TO TIE THE KNOT

A woman scheduled an ultrasound last year, and as often happens, she brought the father of her baby along to the appointment. After sharing about our BRIDGES earn-while-you-learn program, they enrolled. As they continued to meet with our Client Services Director (CSD), they talked about the future and what their thoughts on it were. The CSD explained that it is healthier for both their child and relationship to be married versus cohabitating. Later that next month, they were engaged! Statistics have shown relationships are happier and longer-lasting with a marriage commitment and that children feel more secure and loved with married parents.

The couple was married in November and their baby was born a few months after that. We were able to give them a LAMB shower along with a local church. And they earned the crib with a mattress, a car seat, pack-n-play, diapers, and clothing while attending the BRIDGES appointments. They still come with their baby to keep earning diapers and learning to be better parents and build a stronger family.
