## THE CRISIS

Since 2020, abortions in Pennsylvania have increased by 7%. **That amounts to 88 abortions every day.** 2020 also marked the first year more chemical abortions were performed in Pennsylvania than surgical abortions; now accounting for over half of all statewide abortions. Chemical or medication abortions are pills taken before the woman is 10-weeks pregnant. The first pill stops the baby's heartbeat and the second induces labor to expel the baby.

Due to this crisis, pregnancy resource centers like Crossroads are more essential than ever before. Women and men need support, education, facts, and encouragement before and after making life decisions.

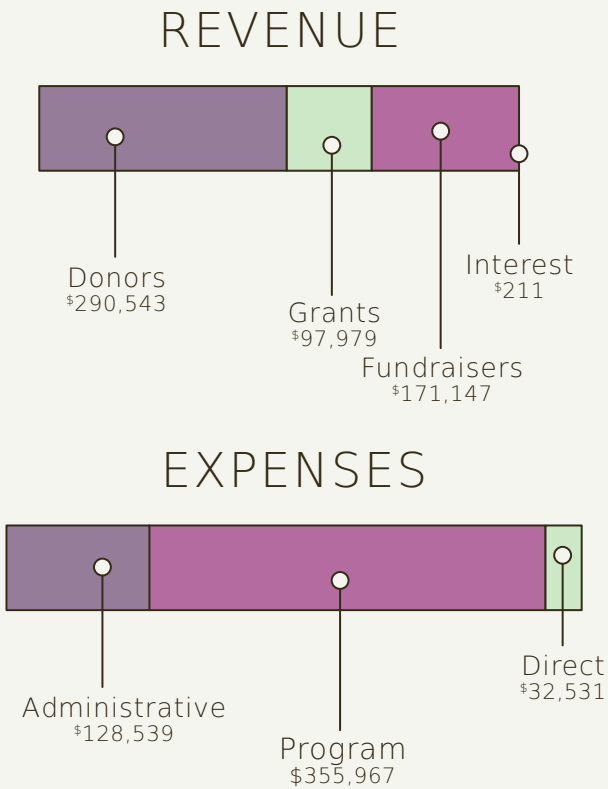
